This activity allows for the perfect opportunity to talk about our freedom, why we are free, and why we are thankful for our freedom.

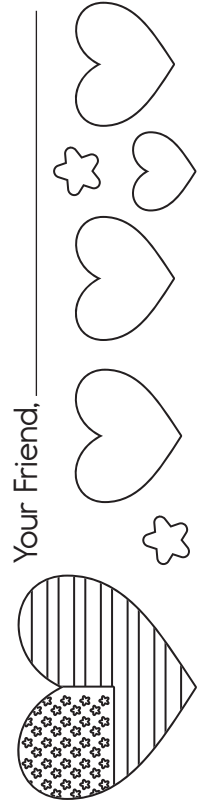




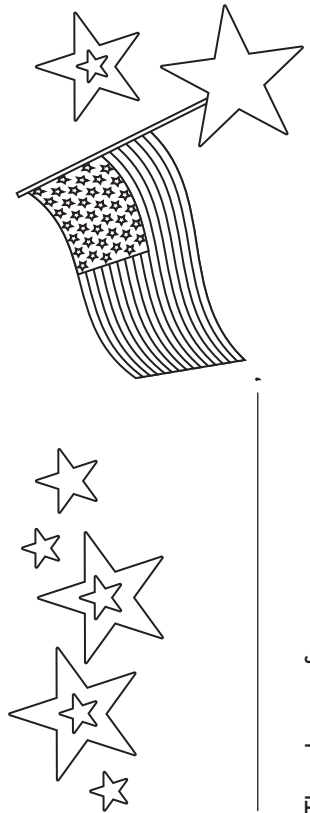
